The Fund is designed for mid- to long-term investors seeking a high level of current income with a moderate level of risk tolerance.

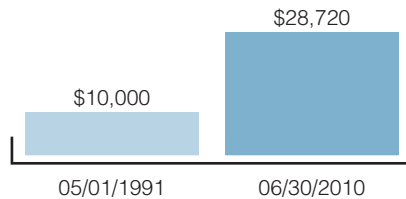

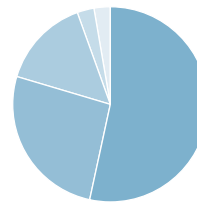

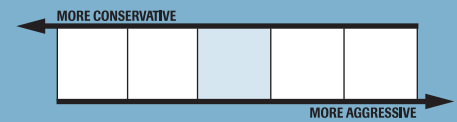
